

*Russian Gulch SP*

Provides a primitive boat launch to the ocean. Support facilities include a 10 vehicle parking lot, restroom, camping hot showers. In addition a search and rescue team serves the park and ocean area.

*Van Damme SP*

Provides a primitive boat launch to the ocean. Support facilities include a 40 vehicle parking lot, restroom, camping, and hot showers. In addition a search and rescue team serves the park and ocean area.

Monterey District

*Asilomar SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

*Carmel River SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach and lagoon areas. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

*Garrapata SP*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. Support facilities include 3 chemical toilets. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

*Marina SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. Support facilities include approximately 80 vehicle parking spaces, and a restroom with flushing toilets. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

*Monterey SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. Support facilities include 2 parking lots with a total of approximately 80 parking spaces, and 4 chemical toilets. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

*Moss Landing SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. Support facilities include approximately 150 parking spaces, and 6 chemical toilets. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

*Point Lobos SR*

Provides a public boat launch ramp with a vessel washing station. Support facilities include approximately 60 vehicles parking spaces, and 6 flushing toilets. In addition 2 inflatable rescue boats (1 boat is owned and maintained by California State Parks the other is owned by Cal Fire) that are staged for search and rescue response.

### *Salinas River SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. Support facilities include 3 parking lots that can accommodate approximately 150 vehicles, and 6 chemical toilets (2 in each parking lot). In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

### *Zmudowski SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch along beach area. Support facilities include a parking lot with approximately 60 spaces, and 2 chemical toilets. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

## North Bay District

### *Angel Island SP*

Provides 47 individual day use boat slips, 27 overnight moorings with a capacity of 108 vessels, beach landing throughout park, a fishing pier, 3 ferry docks and ramps. Support facilities include over 100 picnic sites, 9 restrooms, refuge collection, interpretive signage, two visitor centers, a café and guided tram service. In addition a law enforcement/search and rescue boat serves the park and assists the US Coast Guard in marine operations. The park operates a 57 foot 49 passenger crew boat and a landing craft that provides transportation for equipment and supplies for the park operation and contractors including PG&E and AT&T.

### *China Camp SP*

Provides 1 pier for motorized boat tie off, 1 historic pier and a non-motorized beach launch. Support facilities include day-use area with 200 paved parking spaces, 5 restrooms, interpretive panels, 60 picnic tables and barbeque stands. In addition Bay Operations include law enforcement patrol/search and rescue.

### *Fort Ross SHP*

Provides a non-motorized boat launch. Support facilities include 30 vehicle parking spaces. In addition a search and rescue team including 2 inflatable boats (with engines), and cliff rescue equipment serves the park and water area.

### *Salt Point SP*

Provides a non-motorized boat launch. Support facilities include 30 vehicle parking spaces. In addition a search and rescue team including 2 inflatable boats (with engines), and cliff rescue equipment serves the park and water area.

### *Sonoma Coast SB*

Provides a non-motorized/small motorized boat launch ramp. Support facilities include 10 vehicle parking spaces and 1 restroom facility. In addition a search and rescue team including a 4 meter rigid hull inflatable boat with engine, serves the park and water area. This rescue boat is also available to respond to emergencies at Sonoma Coast SB, Fort Ross SHP, and Salt Point SP.

*Tomales Bay SP*

Provides a non-motorized beach launch area for kayaks, canoes and windsurfing. Support facilities include 200 paved parking spaces 4 pit toilets. In addition a law enforcement patrol/search and rescue team serves the area.

North Coast Redwoods District

*Benbow Lake SRA*

Provides a primitive boat launch. Support facilities include 35 picnic tables and braziers, approximately 150 paved parking spaces, 2 restroom facilities and safety buoys. In addition State Parks also maintains a motorized vessel for search and rescue.

*Humboldt Lagoons SP*

Provides motorized and non-motorized boat launch ramp facilities. Support facilities include 20 vehicle/trailer parking spaces, boat-in camping facility with 5 sites, and 1 vault toilet.

*Humboldt Redwoods SP*

Provides 8 non-motorized boat launches. Support facilities include 3 day-use areas each with approximately 50 vehicle parking spaces, individual and group picnic sites, restrooms, and group camping facilities. In addition a search and rescue team provides swift water rescue operations and patrols using kayaks.

*Jedediah Smith Redwoods SP*

Provides non-motorized boat launches. Support facilities include 93 campsites, 5 restrooms, 1 picnic area, and 40 vehicle parking spaces.

*Richardson Grove SP*

Provides 1 boat launch. Support facilities include paved parking, restroom facilities, and 22 picnic sites.

*Standish-Hickey SRA*

Provides a primitive boat launch to the river.

*Tolowa Dunes SP*

Provides motorized and non-motorized boat launch facility. Support facilities include 1 boarding platform and 5 vehicle/trailer parking spaces.

Northern Buttes District

*Ahjumawi Lava Springs SP*

Provides 9 primitive campsites, boat only access with 3 vault toilets, refuse containers and 1 buoy marker.

*Bidwell-Sacramento River SP*

Provides 2 motorized and 1 non-motorized single lane launch ramps. Support facilities include 3 parking lots that total 130 parking spaces, 6 boating related campsites, 13 day-use sites, two restroom facilities, 2 vault toilets, refuse containers.

*Clear Lake SP*

Provides 1 motorized 2 lane launch ramp with 1 boarding float. Support facilities include 211 parking spaces, 32 boat lighted docking slips, 70 buoy markers of which 1 has navigational lighting, 9 restrooms, 1 fish cleaning station, 8 battery recharging stations for trolling motors, 25 picnic sites, 147 campsites, refuse containers 2 boats for maintenance/patrol. In addition a search and rescue team serves the area.

*Colusa-Sacramento River SP*

Provides 1 motorized 2 lane launch ramp Support facilities include 14 campsites 8 picnic sites, 1 group picnic site, 2 restrooms, 88 vehicle parking places, refuse containers. In addition a search and rescue team serves the area.

*Lake Oroville SRA*

Provides 11 motorized and 2 non-motorized launch ramps with a total of 58 lanes. Support facilities include 2,863 parking spaces, 4 major lighting systems, 3 acres of landscape areas with 4 irrigation systems, 21 restrooms, 14 vault toilets, 3 fish cleaning stations, 10 floating campsites, 7 floating restrooms, 12 boarding floats, 278 campsites, 86 boat-in campsites, 8 group campsites, 304 picnic sites, 228 buoy markers, 15,000 lineal feet of anchor cable, 1 concrete seat staging area specifically for boat tournament presentations, aquatic/education center for boating safety and recreation, refuse containers collecting 1028 tons annually, related signage, maintain and operate 5 patrol boats, 9 maintenance boats, 1 landing craft, 2 concession operated marinas, visitor center and removal of mud and debris from facilities. In addition a search and rescue team serves the area.

*McArthur-Burney Falls MSP*

Provides 1 motorized 2 lane launch ramp with 1 boarding float. Support facilities include 112 parking spaces, 35 boat docking slips, 8 buoy markers, 300ft buoy swim line, 69 picnic sites, 136 campsites, 24 chalet type cabins, 8 restrooms, 1 vault toilet, refuse containers, 1 maintenance/rescue boat and related signage.

*Woodson Bridge SRA*

Provides 3 primitive boat-in group campsites. Support facilities include 33 campsites, 3 restrooms, vault toilets and refuse containers.

San Luis Obispo Coast District

*Limekiln SP*

Provides primitive launching area for kayaks. Support facilities include 33 campsites, restroom facilities and 10 day-use parking spaces. The operation is supported by public safety and year round maintenance.

*Morro Bay SP*

Provides a non-motorized boat launch ramp and boat basin with 75 boat slips. Support facilities include docks, gangways, utilities, 95 paved parking spaces, 135 campsites and restroom facilities. This facility operates year round. Maintenance and law enforcement services are provided on a daily basis.

*San Simeon SP*

Provides a boat launch ramp, and informal kayak launch area. Support facilities include 203 campsites, restroom facilities, over 400 parking spaces (both formal and informal) and 12 day use picnic sites. The operation is supported by year round public safety and maintenance.

*William Randolph Hearst Memorial SB*

Provides kayak launch area and 1 pier. Support facilities include a visitor center, 165 parking spaces, restroom facilities and 15 picnic sites. The operation is supported by year round public safety and maintenance.

Santa Cruz District

*Manresa SB*

Provides primitive boat launch from beach area. Support facilities include day use, beach area, fire rings, swim area, campground, restroom facilities, signs, interpretive panels, and swim/boating marker buoys. In addition a search and rescue team including, personal watercraft, Surf Watch Rescue Boat serves the beach and water area.

*Natural Bridges SB*

Provides kayak/sailboard launch. Support facilities include day use, beach area, fire rings, swim area, campground, restroom facilities, signs and interpretive panels, and swim/boating marker buoys. In addition a search and rescue team including, personal watercraft, Surf Watch Rescue Boat serves the beach and water area.

*Seacliff SB*

Provides primitive boat launch from beach area. Support facilities include day-use, beach area, fire rings, swim area, campground, restroom facilities, signs, interpretive panels, swim/boating marker buoys and a fishing pier. In addition a search and rescue team including, personal watercraft, Surf Watch Rescue Boat serves the beach and water area.

*Sunset SB*

Provides primitive boat launch from beach area. Support facilities include day-use, beach area, fire rings, swim area, campground, restroom facilities, signs, interpretive panels and swim/boating marker buoys. In addition a search and rescue team including, personal watercraft, Surf Watch Rescue Boat serves the beach and water area.

*Twin Lakes SB*

Provides primitive boat launch from beach area. Support facilities include day-use, beach area, fire rings, swim area, campground, restroom facilities, signs and interpretive panels and swim/boating marker buoys. In addition a search and rescue team including, personal watercraft, Surf Watch Rescue Boat serves the beach and water area.

## Sierra District

### *D.L Bliss SP*

Provides a non-motorized launch beach for kayaks, canoes and divers. Support facilities include 50 paved parking spaces, 2 restrooms, interpretive panels, and 5 picnic tables, patrol boat and search and rescue. Adjacent campground has 168 sites.

### *Donner Memorial SP*

Provides 1.5 mile of lakefront non-motorized beach launch, extensive day use area with twenty picnic tables and barbeque stands, 3 rest room buildings, 3 chemical toilets, 30 paved parking spaces, and a well established concession offering motorized boats including personal water crafts, paddleboats and ski boats.

### *Ed Z'berg-Sugar Pine Point SP*

Provides a pier for motorized boat tie off with embarking and disembarking facilities, 1/3 mile of beach for motorized and non-motorized boat tie-off and beach play, a patrol rescue boat, 2 restroom buildings, 40 paved vehicle parking spaces, 2 historic boats and boat houses, picnic grounds, mansion tours patrol boat and search and rescue.

### *Emerald Bay SP*

Provides boat-in campground on Lake Tahoe with 21 campsites, 2 restroom buildings, potable water, pier, 22 buoys; provides kayak concession and launch site, and pier for disembarking to the Vikings Holm mansion, restrooms, mooring location for overnight boat camping, interpretive tours, patrol boat and search and rescue.

### *Kings Beach SRA*

Provides large sandy beach for non-motorized beach launch, pier, restrooms, 50 paved vehicle parking spaces, and concessions for kayaks, personal water craft, ski boats and para-sailing.

### *Mono Lake Tufa SR*

Provides motorized boat ramp launch and unpaved parking for 20 vehicles, day use area at the old marina with parking for 20 and picnic tables with interpretive trails.

### *South Yuba River SP*

Provides launch sites and facilities for river kayakers including 3 day-use areas, 3 restrooms, 1 picnic facility with barbeque stands and 5 picnic tables, and a total of 50 paved parking spaces.

### *Tahoe SRA*

Provides pier, beach for non-motorized beach launch, picnic area with 2 tables, adjacent campground with 20 sites, a restroom building and concession paddlewheel boat operation for tours, meals and parties,

## Angeles District

### *Leo Carrillo SB*

Provides a primitive boat launch. Support facilities include 135 campsites and several buoys. In addition lifeguards respond to aquatic emergencies throughout the year. A personal watercraft and 3-meter inflatable boat are used for offshore search and rescue.

### *Point Mugu SP*

Lifeguards respond to aquatic emergencies throughout the year. A personal watercraft and 3-meter inflatable boat are used for offshore search and rescue.

## Central Valley District

### *Bethany Reservoir SRA*

Provides 1 boat launch ramp. Support facilities include 140 vehicle parking spaces, 2 shaded picnic areas, buoys, 1 accessible vault toilet, and water safety signage. In addition patrols are conducted by patrol vehicles, foot patrols and vessel patrols to include public safety, search and rescue, interpretation, education, resource management and emergency prevention.

### *Caswell Memorial SP*

Provides primitive boat launch. Support facilities include 65 campsites, 1 group camp area, 3 restroom facilities, showers and multiple river access points that include beaches. There are 200 parking spaces, 4 picnic areas and water safety signage and material. In addition patrols are conducted by public safety personnel via vehicle, 15 ft. aluminum Jon boat and by foot patrol. Aquatic patrols include public safety, aquatic interpretation and education, search and rescue and resource management and emergency prevention.

### *McConnell SRA*

Provides primitive boat launch. Support facilities include 21 individual campsites, 2 group campsites, 29 picnic sites, and 2 restrooms with shower facilities, 120 day-use vehicle parking spaces, and water safety signage. In addition public safety is insured by vehicle, vessel, and foot patrols, aquatic education and interpretation.

### *Millerton Lake SRA*

Provides 6 motorized boat launch ramps, and 1 non-motorized boat launch ramp. Support facilities include 70 boat-in camp sites, 27 RV sites, 150 tent sites, and 2 large group camps, 4,986 lake shore parking spaces, a 500 slip marina, approximately 100 buoys, 9,000 feet of anchor cable, and anchors ranging in weight from 45lbs to 1,250lbs each. A fleet of 7 vessels consisting of 3 patrol boats, 1 resource boat, 1 educational barge, 1 sewage pump-out boat and a work barge supporting buoy deployment serves the lake operation. In addition Millerton Lake has extensive law enforcement and a search and rescue team.

### *San Luis Reservoir SRA*

Provides 4 boat launch facilities. Support facilities include 5 boat docks and 550 boat/trailer parking spaces, 300 shoreline picnic and group sites, restroom facilities, 54 site developed campground, 2 large group camp areas and an undeveloped campground with a capacity of 500 campers, 2 radio-activated Wind Warning Light Systems, 80 aquatic safety buoys, and 35 aquatic safety related signs and interpretive displays. In addition a search and rescue team including 3 patrol/rescue boats and one maintenance/tour barge serves the park and water area.

### *Turlock Lake SRA*

Provides 2 boat launch ramps and 1 dock. Support facilities include 2 formal manicured picnic areas, 1 campground picnic area, 6 restroom facilities with disabled accessibility, showers, 63 unit campground, mooring capabilities, 547 vehicle parking spaces, 94 boat vehicle/trailer parking spaces. In addition patrols are conducted by public safety personnel via vehicle, 22 ft. aluminum code 3 vessel and foot patrol. Aquatic patrols include public safety, aquatic interpretation and education, search and rescue and resource management and emergency prevention.

## Channel Coast District

### *Carpinteria SB*

The park offers a non-motorized beach launch for kayaks. Support facilities include 100 paved parking spaces, 8 restrooms, interpretive panels and 20 picnic sites. The park also has a popular campground with 251 individual and 4 group sites, some sites offering full hook-ups.

### *Emma Wood SB*

The park offers a non-motorized beach launch for kayaks and kite surfers. Support facilities include 35 paved parking spaces, 1 restroom, interpretive panels, and 5 picnic tables. Facilities include campgrounds with 91 individual and 8 group sites.

### *Gaviota SP*

The park offers a public pier with a motorized boat hoist launch, a day use area and sandy beach for launching small boats & PWC'S. Facilities include eight picnic sites, 60 parking paved parking spaces, two restrooms, and a park store offering bait, fishing gear and supplies. The park has a popular 42 site campground. Lifeguard staff maintains a ridged-hull inflatable rubber boat (RIRB) and PWC with rescue sled for response to search and rescue and for maintaining boating event buoys.

### *McGrath SB*

The park offers a non-motorized beach launch for kayaks and kite surfers. Park facilities include 15 paved parking spaces, 3 restroom, interpretive panels, and a River's Edge Nature Trail. The park also has a popular 175 site campground.

### *Refugio SB*

The park offers a non-motorized beach launch for small boats, kayaks and PWC'S. The Refugio State Beach Underwater Reserve is popular spot for local divers and anglers. Support facilities include 35 paved parking spaces, 5 restrooms, interpretive panels, outdoor showers and 52 picnic sites. The park has a popular 76 site campground and 1 group camp site.

### *San Buenaventura SB*

The park offers a non-motorized beach launch for kayaks and kite surfers. Support facilities include 900 improved parking spaces, 4 restrooms, interpretive panels, and 112 individual and 16 group picnic sites. Lifeguard staff maintains a PWC with rescue sled for response to search and rescue and for maintaining boating event buoys.

## Colorado Desert District

### *Salton Sea SRA*

Provides a launch ramp and piers for docking up 12 boats (both motorized and non-motorized). Support facilities include a fishing jetty with associated warning lights, restrooms, boat wash area, 60 vehicle/trailer parking spaces, 2 kayak camps that include boat racks, tables, shade ramadas, compost toilets and solar showers. The channel leading out of the harbor is maintained by dredging. In addition a Hydrosport patrol boat and a pontoon boat, is used for research, clean up, and search and rescue.

### *Picacho SRA*

Provides 2 docks with launch ramps for motorized and non-motorized boats. Support facilities include 52 campsites, 2 group camp sites, 4 boat-in camps, water, tables, fire rings, toilets, solar shower building and buoys. Each of the primitive camps has tables, shade ramadas, stoves, vault toilets and a maintained clear area of river access. In addition Picacho has a small pontoon boat/barge used for boat in camp maintenance, and a 22 foot jet boat is used for law enforcement/search and rescue.

## Gold Fields District

### *Auburn SRA*

Provides 1 boat launch with a courtesy dock supported by a maintenance barge and a patrol vessel. Support facilities include 2 stall vault toilets and a floating restroom.

### *Brannan Island SRA*

Provides 1 boat launch with 2 lanes and 2 courtesy docks and a patrol vessel. Support facilities include a maintenance barge, 100 vehicle parking spaces, 1 boat berthing area with 4 berths, 1 restroom building with 4 stalls, 20 picnic tables and 15 barbeques, garbage receptacles, and signage.

### *Delta Meadows*

Provides a primitive boat launch. Support facilities include 1 chemical toilet.

***Folsom Lake SRA***

Provides 15 boat launches (totaling 56 lanes), 2 primitive boat launch sites, and 2 courtesy docks 685 wet boat slips and 175 dry boat slips. Support facilities include 958 vehicle parking spaces, 2,053 combination vehicle/trailer spaces, 50 vehicle gravel spaces, 32 restroom buildings, 2 floating restrooms, 10 vault toilets, 273 picnic tables, 104 barbecues, 6 courtesy docks, 3 ranger patrol vessels, 2 personal watercraft, 1 maintenance barge, 1 maintenance vessel, over 200 buoys, and numerous signs and garbage receptacles. In addition a search and rescue team serves the beach and water area.

***Marshall Gold Discovery SHP***

Provides a raft take out. Support facilities include 55 parking spaces and 1 restroom building with 2 stalls.

**Inland Empire District**

***Lake Perris SRA***

Provides 4 motorized launch ramps with courtesy docks, and 1 primitive dirt launch ramp for non-motorized vessels. Support facilities include 423 combination vehicle/trailer spaces, 481 single vehicle spaces, 5 restroom buildings, 20 chemical toilets, 138 picnic sites, signage, 5 emergency call boxes, a full service marina that includes 160 boat slips, and 50 dry storage spaces. In addition, Lake Perris SRA has two 21 ft. Crystal Liners code 3 patrol vessels (providing law enforcement/search and rescue services), one 22 ft. Design Concepts code three jet boat, 2 pontoon boats and 1 barge.

***Silverwood Lake SRA***

Provides 2 launch ramps (6 lanes & 2 lanes) with 4 associated courtesy boarding docks. Support facilities include; 170 Vehicle/trailer and 350 single vehicle parking spaces with associated landscaping and lighting; 4 permanent restroom buildings; 4 boat-in day use sites complete with 20 picnic sites & 8 chemical toilets; 2 floating restrooms; 100 slip full service marina and 2 large work barges (35 ft. & 18 ft.). Public safety programs include the operation of 3 patrol/rescue boats (22 ft.) providing complete 24 hour law enforcement / search and rescue services; safe boating signage and educational information provided at launch ramps, entrance stations and interpretive programs; courtesy boat inspections and navigational buoy system.

**Orange Coast District**

***Bolsa Chica SB***

Provides a 29 foot, twin engine surf rescue boat used to protect swimmers and boaters within the region.

***Crystal Cove SP***

Provides search and rescue, and several buoys. Patrol boat provided by Huntington SB. The underwater portion of Crystal Cove State Park provides boating opportunities for vessels launched in Newport Harbor and Dana Point.

***San Clemente SB***

Provides search and rescue, several buoys. Patrol boat provided by Doheny SB.
