

San Onofre SB

Provides search/rescue and several buoys. Patrol boat provided by Doheny SB. Includes areas for non-motorized equipment including kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards.

Huntington SB

Provides a 29 foot, twin engine surf rescue boat used to protect swimmers and boaters within the region. This patrol boat also covers Crystal Cove SB.

Doheny SB

Provides a 29 foot, twin engine surf rescue boat used to protect swimmers and boaters within the region. This patrol boat also covers San Clemente and San Onofre SB. Includes areas for non-motorized equipment including kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards.

San Diego District

Cardiff SB

Area is utilized by non-motorized equipment including kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards as well as by divers, kite surfers, surfers, swimmers, and waders. California State Parks provides lifeguard services for state property within the city of Encinitas. Support facilities include 2 large day-use lots providing 575 parking spaces, and accommodation facilities, including 2 day-use restrooms.

Carlsbad SB

Provides lifeguard services for the City of Carlsbad and has launching areas for non-motorized equipment including kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards. Support facilities include 1 day-use lot providing 129 parking spaces as well as city on-street and nearby parking, an urban boardwalk, and accommodation facilities, including 1 day-use restroom. In addition lifeguard services performs boating safety and law enforcement using Rescue Water Craft (RWC/PWC) and a Rigid Hull Inflatable Boat (RIB), to perform patrol of beach and ocean, and rescue operations during periods of high use and hazardous surf conditions.

San Elijo SB

Provides support for non-motorized equipment including kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards. Support facilities include 1 day-use lot providing 70 parking spaces, a campground with 171 sites, and accommodation facilities, including 2 day-use restrooms. In addition lifeguards provide law enforcement/rescue services.

Silver Strand SB

Silver Strand State Beach is affiliated via a MOU with South Western Junior College, which provides numerous boating classes for the public at this unit. Crown Cove within Silver Strand SB has 2 day-use mooring locations for vessels. Support at Silver Strand includes 4 day-use parking lots, providing approximately 900 spaces, a campground with 140 sites, and 8 restroom buildings. Lifeguards are also responsible for maintaining 4 buoys in the Crown Cove area. Lifeguards provide shore based rescue services for boats in distress on the bay. Rescue Water Craft (RWC/PWC) and a Rigid Hull Inflatable Boat (RIB), ocean, and rescue operations including vessel tows, vessel rescue from surf line, and person overboard calls.

South Carlsbad SB

Provides Lifeguard Services for the City of Carlsbad and has launching areas for non-motorized equipment including kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards. Support facilities include 2 day-use lots providing 307 parking spaces as well as city on-street and nearby parking, campground with 220 sites, and accommodation facilities, including 2 day-use restrooms. In addition, lifeguard services performs boating safety and law enforcement using Rescue Water Craft (RWC/PWC) and a Rigid Hull Inflatable Boat (RIB), to perform patrol of beach and ocean, and rescue operations during periods of high use and hazardous surf conditions. State Parks maintains one recognized buoy off the south end of South Carlsbad State Beach. The buoy is considered a navigation mark for the USCG and must be maintained to their satisfaction.

Torrey Pines SB

Ocean provides recreation area for motorized boating, kayakers, kite surfers, surfers, swimmers, waders, and divers. California State Parks provides Lifeguard Services for state beach areas within the City of San Diego and Del Mar. Support includes three day-use lots providing 1000 parking spaces, interpretive panels, and accommodation facilities, including 3 day-use restrooms.
